The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica

The church of **St John on the Lantern** in Rome is 'Mother and Head of all the churches of the City and the World'. It is the cathedral church of the Bishop of Rome, and was called 'St John' after the two monasteries once attached, dedicated to St John the Divine and St John the Baptist. It is, however, dedicated to the Most Holy Saviour.
